Active grants & programs in 2005

The Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation's primary mission is to fund medical research into the cause and cure of childhood brain tumors. With guidance from our highly skilled Scientific Advisory Board, we choose to fund promising research projects around the world. No matter where a discovery is made, it will benefit children of all nations.

Scientists in the United States, Canada and Australia conducted research associated with the PBTF in 2005. Grants being funded in 2005 represent a commitment by the PBTF of more than \$8 million in research dollars.

Those dollars include research grants totaling \$2.25 million for three pre-Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation Institute grants at the University of San Francisco, Childrens Hospital Los Angeles, and the Hospital for Sick Children; two basic research grants to the Baylor College of Medicine and St. Jude Children's Research Hospital; and our ongoing financial commitment to the PBTF Institute at Duke University.

The new grants will enable researchers at these institutions to collaborate to generate scientific knowledge of pediatric brain tumors that will bring about innovative and less invasive clinical treatments. (For more details, see page 3.)

PBTF Institute Awards

University of California at San Francisco, Program on Pediatric Brain Tumor Biology and Therapeutics, Mitchel S. Berger, M.D., Principal Investigator.

Certain types of pediatric brain tumors, brainstem glioma and medulloblastoma in particular, are associated with poor outcomes. This research proposal from UCSF includes five projects that address these problems using new approaches.

Project 1 focuses on the developmental origin of brainstem gliomas with the overall aim of identifying stem cells within the brainstem that may cause malignant gliomas. Project 2 will grow pediatric brain tumors directly in a hosts. This approach facilitates a detailed characterization of these tumors, as well as providing a resource for other projects.

Project 3 explores the role of specific oncogene, MYCN, that is important for the development of medulloblastoma. This project will also study the effect of an exciting new family of agents that target this oncogene.

Project 4 will study medulloblastoma using a number of new techniques that allow the

entire genome to be analyzed. Also, a technique called siRNA inhibition will be used to turn off specific genes that may drive tumor growth.

Project 5 will study two new strategies convection-enhanced delivery and intranasal delivery, to directly place chemotherapy drugs into the brainstem. Finally, these projects will be supported through an Administrative Core and a Pediatric Brain Tumor Bank.

Promise of the future: Collaborations in pediatric brain tumor research

As our executive director, Aggie Alexander, says, “Even one child diagnosed with a brain tumor is one child too many.” It is with that attitude that the Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation funds research.

We’ve always tried to “think outside the box” when it comes to finding new ways to support pediatric brain tumor research. In 1992, we pledged to financially support the establishment of the Central Brain Tumor Registry and made it our goal to encourage basic science researchers to focus on pediatric brain tumors, as well as adult brain tumors.

PBTF also answered the request of pediatric neuro-oncologists to support clinical trials research and responded to a request from the Pediatric Brain Tumor Consortium (PBTC) with funds to establish the PBTC virtual Neuro-Imaging Center. We were one of the first to fund quality of life studies for pediatric brain tumor survivors, and we provided a founding grant to the Society of Neuro-Oncology to start the medical journal *Neuro-Oncology*.

In 2001, after consultation with our Scientific Advisory Board and the National Cancer Institute (NCI), the PBTF decided to fund a \$1.25 million, five-year research grant for pediatric brain tumors.

It was with an eye to the future that we then committed to encouraging collaborative research efforts for pediatric brain tumor research. In 2003, we granted \$6 million to start the first Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation Institute at Duke University, with multiple research projects and collaborative efforts with researchers in the United States, the United Kingdom and Germany.

At the time, we announced our intention to expand this PBTF Institute initiative so that additional research collaborations could be formed. That opportunity came in 2005, when we committed a total of \$900,000, over three years, to support three

pre-PBTF Institutes at the University of California at San Francisco, Childrens Hospital Los Angeles and the Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto, Canada. We also funded \$100,000 in basic research grants at St. Jude Children’s Research Hospital and Texas Children’s Hospital, gave \$1 million to the PBTFI at Duke, and supported various brain tumor research meetings, grants and research awards as well.



Specialized Programs of Research Excellence

A model for research collaborations has been created by the NCI through their Specialized Programs of Research Excellence (SPORE). There are currently four brain tumor SPORE programs—at the University of California at San Francisco, University of Alabama at Birmingham, Duke University and the Mayo Clinic. A SPORE’s mission is to translate basic research discoveries into new therapies through individual and collaborative efforts.

Patient advocates are appointed to this program in an effort to ensure that patients’ needs and viewpoints are represented when these research efforts are translated into clinical trials. I have had the privilege to serve as a patient advocate to the brain tumor SPOREs, and it has been rewarding to witness and participate in their research collaborations.

Currently, clinical trials are being designed that will involve patients from each institution. Recently, the SPORE institutions committed to including a collaborative pediatric brain tumor research project as a part of their programs. It is very exciting that this will be the only childhood cancer being addressed by the many types of cancer SPOREs. We salute the brain tumor SPOREs for their commitment to children with pediatric brain tumors. □

PBTF awards \$2.25 million in new research grants in 2005

Research into the deadliest type of childhood cancer received a significant boost in 2005 from the PBTF, which awarded research grants totaling \$2.25 million. Pre-Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation Institute grants went to researchers at the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF), Childrens Hospital Los Angeles (CHLA), and the Hospital for Sick Children (SickKids) in Toronto, Canada. Basic research grants were also awarded to Baylor University College of Medicine and St. Jude Children’s Research Hospital.

The UCSF, CHLA and SickKids pre-PBTF Institute grants join the foundation’s ongoing financial commitment to the Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation Institute at Duke University, directed by Darell Bigner, M.D., Ph.D. The PBTF-Duke Institute is devoted exclusively to pediatric

brain tumor research. With these new grants, the researchers at UCSF, CHLA, SickKids and Duke will collaborate to generate scientific knowledge of pediatric brain tumors that will bring about innovative and less invasive clinical treatments.

To determine the 2005 awards, the PBTF invited institutions to apply for the pre-Institute grants based on certain prerequisites, including a commitment to significantly advance pediatric brain tumor research within their institutions. The pre-Institute grant winners were chosen by a scientific peer review committee. Over the next three years, they are expected to make substantial research progress. In year three, if appropriate progress has been made, they will be invited to reapply for an additional two years of funding. The basic grants to Baylor and St. Jude were also awarded through peer review.

“When we established the Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation Institute at Duke with a six-year, \$6 million dollar grant in 2003, it was with an eye toward expanding to other institutions in the future,” said Dianne Traynor, PBTF’s director of research and advocacy. “The collaboration of these institutions will help to fast-forward our understanding of pediatric brain tumors.”

The principal investigator at UCSF is Mitchel S. Berger, M.D., chair of neurological surgery at UCSF Medical Center and director of its Brain Tumor Research Center. At CHLA, the lead researcher is Robert C. Seeger, M.D., director of the Cancer Program at the hospital’s Saban Research Institute. And at SickKids, the research team is headed by James Rutka, M.D., Ph.D., FRCS, co-director of the Arthur and Sonia Labatt Brain Tumour Research Centre. □

Childrens Hospital Los Angeles, Biology and Therapy of Pediatric Brain Tumors: Saving Lives, Saving Neurons, Robert C. Seeger, M.D., Principal Investigator.

Biology and Therapy of Pediatric Brain Tumors: Saving Lives, Saving Neurons is based on the idea that improvement in survival and quality of life for children with brain tumors will come from a better understanding of these tumors. The research focuses on tumors diagnosed before ten years of age.

Project 1 determines the “molecular portrait” of medulloblastomas to discover genes that are important in cancer behavior and that may be targets for treatment. Project 2 investigates how medulloblastomas and gliomas create new blood vessels, which allow tumors to grow, and develops treatments to kill blood vessels to shrink tumors.

Project 3 studies how cells of the immune system called natural killer T cells (NKT) can be used to treat gliomas. Project 4 tests anti-cancer drugs for activity against childhood brain tumors using a laboratory-based test system that can determine the best way to combine different drugs.

Project 5 images brain stem gliomas in patients to obtain information for developing and evaluating new therapies. These studies will advance knowledge about childhood brain tumors and will lead to more effective diagnosis, classification, and treatment.

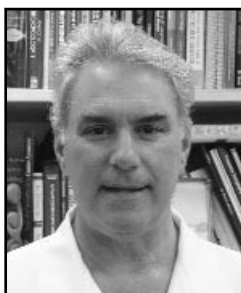

In the past, the limited number of genes identified as important in the pathogenesis of medulloblastoma have been identified using a candidate gene approach. We hypothesize that recently developed techniques in genomics and molecular genetics will allow us to identify novel oncogenes and tumor suppressor genes not previously suspected as playing a role in the etiology of medulloblastoma. Identification of the key genetic events in the initiation, maintenance and progression of medulloblastoma will allow for the rational design of targeted therapeutic strategies.

2005 Basic Research Awards

Baylor College of Medicine, Adoptive Immunotherapy for Medulloblastoma with EfbB2-specific T cells, Stephen Gottschalk, M.D.

The long-term objective of this project is to develop an innovative, immunotherapeutic approach for medulloblastoma. Patients with local disease have a good prognosis; however, long-term survivors suffer from treatment-related complications.

For patients with incompletely resected and/or metastatic disease the outcome remains poor. It is therefore desirable to develop novel therapies that could improve outcomes for patients with refractory disease, and which might ultimately reduce the incidence of long-term treatment-related complications in all patients.

Cellular immunotherapies have the potential to fulfill both of these needs. This proposal aims to develop a new immunotherapeutic approach for medulloblastoma at higher levels than normal cells. We will generate ErbB2-

specific T cells by introducing a so-called chimeric receptor gene into T cells. Chimeric receptors will be first optimized in the tissue culture and then tested in models of human medulloblastoma.

We expect at the conclusion of this project to have established an efficient system for the generation of ErbB2-specific T cells, which not only kill ErbB2-positive medulloblastomas but also expand after infusion, as a foundation for clinical trial.

St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, Identification of Genes Involved in Medulloblastoma, Martine F. Roussel, Ph.D.

Medulloblastoma, the most common malignant brain tumor of childhood, is a devastating disease. Although many children are cured by combinational therapies, their quality of life is severely impaired. We have genetically engineered strains of mice that are predisposed to medulloblastoma development, and we now recognize a genetic “signature” in which only few genes are aberrantly up-regulated.

We can now ask how each gene contributes to disease and pinpoint those that are particularly important for tumor initiation, progression and response to drug therapy. Our general approach is to purify susceptible neuronal progenitor cells from the developing cerebellum, create specific genetic defects in them, and then re-inject the modified cell back into the brain.

One of our tricks is to “mark” the manipulated cells with a gene encoding a fluorescent protein and inject the cells

under a cranial window, so that tumor development can be visualized in real time. Once tumors appear, we excise and transplant them into other mice, giving us a pre-clinical model for testing novel drugs specifically targeted to gene products of interest.

In principle, such “targeted therapy” would differ from currently used chemotherapeutic agents in attacking the root cause of the tumor without affecting normal cells.

“Miracles do happen”

By all accounts, Karina is a pretty cool kid: a 3.92 high school GPA, the dean’s list at college and a record of community service activities that would make even a career volunteer take note. Now add the fact that this young lady was diagnosed with a

malignant brain tumor at the tender age of 19 months, and you begin to get a sense of just how outstanding she really is.

Even though Karina doesn’t remember much about her infant days with a brain tumor, she does know that she had to relearn how to walk, sit and crawl and that her speech was also affected. And although she is still challenged by depth and visual perception issues, what she can’t do pales in comparison to what she can.

Currently studying business administration at Mira Costa College in Cardiff, Calif., Karina plans to transfer to California State University at Northridge, where she wants to earn a bachelor of arts in deaf studies. Her goal is to teach deaf and hearing-impaired junior high students, offering support and inspiration from her own life. “Since I have had difficulties in the past and have worked to overcome them, I would like to help other students do the same,” she said in her application for a PBTf college scholarship.

Karina also relates to issues of loneliness and isolation that often surface among kids who feel “different.” “I know how it feels when you do not fit in or to have a ‘barrier’ between yourself and other kids. Having a sense of value can be difficult under these circumstances and I would like to help children achieve this,” she said. That philosophy is the engine that motivated Karina, despite motor control problems on her left side, to earn a second-degree black belt in Tae Kwon Do.

All this hard work has not gone unnoticed. After volunteering more than 200 hours at a camp for children who are deaf and hard of hearing, Karina was named a delegate to the 2002 Annual Youth Leadership Forum for Students with Disabilities sponsored by the California Governor’s Committee for the Employment of Disabled Persons. The experience reinforced her conviction to seek a college degree and help others.

Exuding an optimistic outlook comes easily to Karina, and makes her an inspiration to anyone she meets. It is not surprising that her college counselor refers to her as “a study in excellence in all areas of her life.” Perhaps Karina’s own words best describe her attitude. “At the time of my diagnosis, I was 19 months old. The doctors told my parents I probably would not see my second birthday. This year I will be 20. Miracles do happen.” □

PBTF works with Alliance to advance survivorship issues

As a founding member of the Alliance for Childhood Cancer, the PBTF works with more than 20 other national patient advocacy groups and professional medical and scientific organizations. Patient advocates, many of whom are either cancer survivors themselves or are parents of children with cancer, are joined by oncology professionals and others representing the multidisciplinary spectrum of cancer care in a unique alliance that brings concerned parties together to advance the interests of children with cancer.

The Alliance also briefs policymakers on issues facing children with cancer. In 2002, it adopted core principles for ensuring quality care that address seven areas of critical importance for children and adolescents living with cancer, and is now working on similar principles for survivorship and long-term follow-up care.

“Long-term survivors may receive follow-up care from a range of providers, including oncologists, non-oncology specialists, primary care physicians and other health care providers, and this care may be provided in a variety of environments,” the survivorship principles state. “The variations in systems and sites for care may reflect the age and diagnosis of the patient, original site of care, geography, insurance coverage and survivor awareness. The care that survivors receive may be comprehensive and multidisciplinary and therefore adequate to meet survivors’ needs, but it may also fail to meet the minimum standards necessary to ensure good outcomes for survivors of childhood and adolescent cancer.”

To address these problems, the Alliance has drafted principles to guide initiatives to improve access, awareness and education, research, and treatment for childhood cancer survivors.

One of the topics covered is insurance coverage for post-treatment monitoring, long-term follow-up and care and treatment of late effects, especially important when parents change jobs or employers change insurance plans, as well as when children become adults. Another is the importance of access to care from a variety of specialists and health care providers, both during and after treatment for the primary illness.

The Alliance also suggests a national pediatric cancer survivor registry to help formulate and guide research and provider education efforts on survivorship, the prevention and treatment of late-effects.

“Our hope is that these principles will help policymakers in Congress as they craft legislation dealing with cancer care, and that care providers and insurance companies will keep them in mind when devising treatment plans,” said Dianne Traynor, the director of research and advocacy for the PBTF. “If enough voices make this message clear, we can help improve the quality of life and care for pediatric brain tumor survivors.” □

Firstgiving.com provides online fundraising pages that can be personalized and e-mailed to friends, family and co-workers to request secure online donations. We launched this in 2005 and had great response from our fundraisers, with more than 50 personal fundraising pages. In fact, a number of PBTF fundraisers are already collecting donations for 2006.

Brain tumor survivor Nathan is a Firstgiving.com success story. Like a lot of 15-year-olds, he needed a nudge at first. “My parents saw it on the brochure for the South Florida Ride for Kids. They told me about it and, after a little procrastination, I made the website (firstgiving.com/nathanlundell) about ten days or so before the [Jan. 22] ride.”

Success for Nathan came overnight—literally. “I set my goal at \$500 the night I made the site and by the time I woke up the next morning, I had already exceeded it. Success comes from what you write. If you show that this really means something to you, people are more likely to help.”
